1060 Cabernet Sauvignon – Merlot - Cabernet Franc 2018

The wine

1060 Cabernet Sauvignon - Merlot - Cabernet Franc 2018 was made with great attention to detail. The unique vineyard is at an elevation of 1,060 m. (3,477 ft.) above sea level. The grapes were carefully sorted on arrival at the winery and then underwent cold soaking at 10-12°C (50-53°F) before fermentation, in search of a delicate extraction of colors, aromas, and flavors.

The wine is bright, with a deep red color, and elegant aromas of black berries and white micromeria. The palate is of blueberries and fresh red fruits, as well as a hint of Mediterranean herbs. It is full bodied, with soft tannins and was aged for 24 months in oak barrels.

The vineyards

Odem Mountain Winery is at Moshav Odem in the northern Golan Heights.

Our plots are set at the northeastern Golan Heights, the highest and coldest vine growing region in Israel. they are characterized by volcanic soil, reaching up to 1,060 m. (3,477 ft.) and receives snowfall in the winter.

The vintage

The vintage of 2018 was relatively early and short.

A warm winter and drought led to early awakening of the vineyards in the spring. The harvest was early and short with no extreme conditions, a successful harvest was concluded.
