



VIOGNIER

*The 2009 Viognier has a yellow-gold hue with aromas of white flowers, peach and young apricot. Northern Rhone in character, it reveals delicate fruit flavors on the attack and mid-palate, good acidity, excellent structure and a persistent finish.
A terrific wine.*





FOREST

A blend of 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Petit Verdot, and 7% each Merlot and Malbec, aged for 12 months in French oak.

Velvety in texture and clinging to the palate, it is complex and earthy, a bit of game showing, fairly deep and pointed, with fine fruit and good aging potential.

Brooding at first, becoming ethereal as it airs out and caressing the palate in

an utterly sensual fashion, it seems both intense and graceful at the same time, a hard feat to accomplish. It was just a joy to drink.





CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*Impenetrably dark garnet in color,
full-bodied, with firm tannins
and gentle wood influence
integrating nicely. On first attack
black fruits and spices, those
parting to show notes of fresh
herbs, black olives and bitter-
sweet chocolate. Drink
now—2015.*





SAUVIGNON BLANC

With half of the wine developed in used barriques for three months and the remainder in stainless steel, a wine that is simultaneously crisply refreshing and complex, with just the barest hint of the wood to add to its charm. Light golden in color, with fine aromatics and delicious balancing acidity to highlight grapefruit, kiwi, green apple and melon notes all on a background of sea shells and flint.





BLEND

Deep purple color, medium to full-body, soft tannins with smoky wood, plum and currant fruit flavors.





BLEND

Red is a delicious blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Shiraz, Petit Verdot and Malbec. It exhibits an opaque ruby color and is very ripe and soft on the palate with moderate red and black fruit and meaty, earth flavors. The wine is nicely balanced and drinkable now.





SYRAH

*Deep Red Purple color, with
aromas of Ripe raspberry,
beetroot & roasted chestnuts.
Rich and fruity on the palate
with a hint of white pepper
on the finish.*





FOREST 2011

*The Forest is an opaque black
ruby colored blend of 58% Cabernet
Sauvignon, 32% Petit Verdot, 5%
Merlot, 3% Malbec and
2% Cabernet Franc.*
